

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
FM 1093: W of FM 359/Main to E of FM 359/Main
FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the City of Fulshear will conduct a public meeting regarding the proposed realignment of FM 1093 in the vicinity of FM 359/Main. The meeting will be held on Monday, September 21, 2009 at the Irene Stern Fulshear Community Center at 6920 Fulshear-Katy Road, Fulshear Texas 77441. Exhibits will be available for viewing from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the proposed realignment and alternatives considered for FM 1093 from West of FM 359/Main to East of FM 359 Main. The meeting will be an open house format. Exhibits will be displayed and representatives from TxDOT and the study team will be available to answer individual questions.

Additional right-of-way will be required for the proposed action, however no displacements will be necessary. Personnel from the TxDOT Right of Way division will be available to discuss the procedures, benefits, programs and provide other needed information regarding land acquisition.

A schematic plan showing the proposed location and geometric design are on file and available for inspection at the district project development office at 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas.

Persons interested in attending the public meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact TxDOT's Public Information Office at 713-802-5072 at least two working days prior to the meeting. TxDOT offices are open Monday - Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding national holidays. Since the public meeting will be conducted in English, any requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least two working days prior to the public meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this public meeting. Written comments relative to the proposed project may be submitted at the meeting or to the Director of Project Development, Texas Department of Transportation, P.O. Box 1386, Houston, Texas, 77251-1386. Comments may also be submitted electronically to hou-piowebmail@dot.state.tx.us. Written comments submitted electronically or by mail must be post marked by October 5, 2009.
